Subject: Urgent Update: Tariffs on Chinese Imports

Dear NFA Members,

We are writing to inform you about recent developments concerning tariffs on fireworks imported from China. On January 31, 2025, the White House announced a 10% tariff on imports from China, effective February 4, 2025. This action is part of a broader trade initiative that also includes tariffs on imports from Mexico and Canada.
